**ORDER**

Petitioners,

For the Dissolution of Citywide Corporate Transportation,  
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Corporation Law.

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WHEREAS, petitioner Citywide Corporate Transportation, Inc. (“Citywide”), by its attorneys, Pike & Pike, P.C., moved this Court by Order to Show Cause for an Order pursuant to §§ 1113 and 1114 of New York’s Business Corporation Law, authorizing and directing the payment of a final disbursement to each shareholder of the petitioner corporation, authorizing the payment of outstanding indebtedness for professional services rendered, and permitting Citywide to dissolve; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the Order to Show Cause, petitioner corporation served each known shareholder with a copy of the Order to Show Cause without the supporting papers, together with a letter providing a summary of the requested relief, and informing shareholders that the supporting papers could be obtained from the website of petitioners’ counsel or obtained upon request from counsel; and

WHEREAS, by order dated March 20, 2017 the Court granted the payment of the aforesaid disbursements to the shareholders and the outstanding indebtedness as detailed in the Order to Show Cause, and directed the submission of the within proposed order;

NOW, THEREFORE, upon the affirmation and supplemental affirmations of Roberta C. Pike dated August 5, 2016 and September 12, 2016 and the exhibits thereto, and upon the prior orders of the Court dated January 31, 2008 (Saks, J.), July 6, 2011 (Barone, J.), November 7, 2012, (Walker, J.), November 17, 2014 (Sherman, J.) and February 16, 2016 (Sherman, J.), and it appearing that the

escrow account maintained for Citywide has a balance of \$228,386.04 including \$23,665.00 in distribution checks issued to and returned and/or uncashed by shareholders, it is hereby ORDERED that the petitioner Corporation and/or its attorneys are herewith authorized to pay the following:

1. The sum of \$891.50 to each of the shareholders identified in the Order to Show Cause;

2. The sum of \$42,463.00 for legal work performed by Pike & Pike, P.C. and invoiced during the period June 2, 2014 through August 5, 2016;

3. The sum of \$4,102.18 to Pike & Pike, P.C. for disbursements incurred during the period October 1, 2012 through June 1, 2014;

4. The sum of \$6,300.00 for projected legal work and up to \$1,065.27 in projected disbursements that will be incurred on behalf of Citywide in connection with the winding up of its affairs;

5. The sum of \$3,100.00 to Steven W. Gordon for accounting services rendered, and the further sum of \$1,550.00 representing fees that will be incurred in connection with the preparation of Citywide's final corporate tax return;

6. The sum of \$23,665.00 to the Office of the State Comptroller representing distributions previously issued to shareholders once those monies have remained unclaimed for the statutory three year period specified in N.Y. Abandoned Property Law § 1315(2); and

7. To pay to the Office of the State Comptroller of all additional unclaimed distributions that remain in Citywide's escrow account three years following issuance, and all other and further corporate monies that remain in Citywide's escrow account three years following dissolution.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order with Notice of Entry be posted upon counsel's website, and served upon the respondent corporation and the New York State Tax Commission by first class mail.


