

WHEREAS, petitioner Citywide Corporate Transportation, Inc., by its attorneys, Pike &  
Pike, P.C., moved this Court by Order to Show Cause for an Order pursuant to §§ 1113 and 1114  
of New York's Business Corporation Law, authorizing and directing the payment of a partial  
disbursement to each shareholder of the petitioner corporation, and the payment of outstanding  
indebtedness for professional services rendered, pending final dissolution of the petitioner  
corporation; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the Order to Show Cause, petitioner corporation served each  
known shareholder with a copy of the Order to Show Cause without the supporting papers, together  
with a letter providing a summary of the requested relief, and informing shareholders that the  
supporting papers could be obtained from the website of petitioners' counsel or obtained upon  
request from counsel (the "Web Publication Method"); and

WHEREAS, by order dated October 31, 2014, the Court granted the payment of the aforesaid  
partial disbursements to the shareholders and the outstanding indebtedness as detailed in the Order  
to Show Cause, and directed the submission of the within proposed order; and

WHEREAS, the August 1, 2014 Affirmation of petitioners' counsel, Roberta C. Pike,  
submitted in support of the Order to Show Cause represents that the anticipated cost of service of

the Order to Show Cause utilizing the Web Publication Method was projected to be the same as the cost incurred in serving the prior Order to Show Cause (\$7,971.00);

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the petitioner Corporation is herewith authorized to pay the following:

1. Payment of the sum of \$200.00 to each of the shareholders set forth on Exhibit "9" to the Order to Show Cause;
2. Payment of the sum of \$18,937.50 for legal work performed by Pike & Pike, P.C. and invoiced during the period October 1, 2012 through June 1, 2014, as detailed on the invoices annexed as Exhibit "7" to the Order to Show Cause;
3. Payment of the sum of \$576.32 to Pike & Pike, P.C. for disbursements incurred during the period October 1, 2012 through June 1, 2014, as detailed on the invoices annexed as Exhibit "7" to the Order to Show Cause;
4. Payment of the sum of \$3,000.00 to Steven W. Gordon for accounting services as set forth on the invoice annexed as Exhibit "8" to the Order to Show Cause; and
5. Payment to Pike & Pike, P.C. in the lesser of the sum of \$7,971.00 or the actual costs incurred in connection with service of the Order to Show Cause utilizing the Web Publication Method.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order with Notice of Entry be posted upon counsel's website, and served upon the respondent corporation and the New York State Tax Commission by first class mail.




